HANTS & DORSET AMATEUR ROWING ASSOCIATION.

The Association Secretaries Report to the Annual General Meeting on the 1998 Rowing Season.

The granting of a Regatta Permit to Worthing Rowing Club, allowing them to stage a Hants & Dorset Regatta for the first time for many years increased the number of Championship Regatta's to 15 for the 1998 season - and in spite of some difficult conditions - in particular at Ryde and at Southsea which had to be postponed - all the Regatta's were completed. Entries at all Regatta's increased to 1,432 - an increase of 84 or 6% over 1997 - if Worthing is excluded Regatta entries still increased by 6 or 0.5%. Only three Regatta's exceeded 100 entries - Bournemouth, Shanklin and Southsea - which, as always was the largest Regatta with 172 entries - 90 of these coming from Hants & Dorset Clubs. A further four Regatta's had more than 90 entries - and the entry at Newport increased significantly from 40 in 1997 to 79 in 1998. The entry to Milford was also significantly higher - BTC and Christchurch suffering the largest fall in entries.

The Men's Senior Fours event was dominated by BTC who retained the Championship once again, their 3rd in a row. The BTC A crew won 13 of the Regatta's, including the Portsmouth Grand Challenge Trophy at Southsea Regatta. Their BTC C crew snatched another win for the Club with the other Regatta being won by Vospers, who with Lymington mounted the main challenge to BTC's domination of this event.

There was an even more dominating performance in the Men's Junior Senior Fours Championship where Christchurch won 14 out of the 15 races - only losing at Southsea - where they will still be the first Hants & Dorset crew home - and so achieved the rare feat of claiming all 15 Championship points. The challenge to their domination came initially from Ryde, then from Shanklin and finally from BTC but they were never seriously threatened.

The Men's Junior fours was a much more closely fought contest with four clubs winning during the season - Vospers and Westover were the early winners - each ending up with 3. But by mid-season Southampton and BTC were emerging as the likely Champions with Southampton snatching the honours with 5 wins to BTC's 4.

Nine different Clubs won Men's Novice Fours races with the standard remaining high right through the season although the entries were inevitably low by the last few Regatta's. The Championship ended up as a three way split between BTC, Southsea and Poole - each with three wins while single wins were recorded by Lymington, Christchurch, Coalporters, Vospers and Southampton.

In the Ladies Senior fours event Southampton, runners-up for the last two years, regained the Championship with an impressive 12 wins from 15 Regatta's during the season. Worthing won two races, but only claimed one point - and the Championship may have been closer had they competed in more Hants & Dorset Regatta's. The remaining point was claimed by BTC who won the last Association Regatta of the season.

The Ladies Junior Fours was a two-horse race between Poole and Southsea with Poole emerging as Champions with eight wins against Southsea's 7. However this was a remarkable achievement by the Southsea Crew who were Novice at the start of the season and actually won their Novice race and first Junior race at the same Regatta - they

were fortunate the programme on the day allowed them to do this.

Eight Club won Novice Ladies fours events with BTC claiming the Championship with their four wins. Coalporters were runners-up with three wins, Christchurch and Vospers had two apiece and Poole, Lymington, Southsea and Shanklin had one win each.

The men's Senior Pairs was another closely fought championship with the honours only being decided at the last Regatta where Christchurch's first round win over rivals Lymington effectively gave them the Championship by six points to five. Poole, Southampton and Southsea also recorded single wins in this event.

Southsea - who are arguably the Associations small boat specialists - did even better in the Men's Junior Pairs winning 9 of the Regatta's to take the Championship with Coalporters with 5 wins runners-up.

Half of Southampton's Championship winning Ladies Senior Four competed in and also dominated the Ladies Pairs event - winning ten of the thirteen Regatta's that staged the event. Worthing with two wins and a single win for Lymington completed the results.

Kenny Chalk of Lymington duly retained his Men's Senior Single Sculls Championship recording 9 wins against his old rival - Mike Gisborne of Southsea who won the other 4 Regatta's.

In the Men's Junior Sculls yet another Southsea Sculler emerged as Association Champion - Andy Stearne winning 11 of the Regatta's with Williams of Coalporters winning twice and Gathergood of Worthing recording a single win.

A slightly disappointing Ladies Sculling Championship saw Lesley Walters of Worthing and Kay Hume of BTC wins six events each - with Lesley taking the Championship as she gained more points because of the low turnout in some of the races Kay won. Kenway of Christchurch recorded a single win.

Wayne Harrison of BTC, the cox of their Championship winning Men's Senior Four was awarded the prestigious Coxswain of the Year trophy.

Southsea with 36 Championship wins emerged as the seasons most successful Club with BTC with 32 wins second and Southampton with 29 wins third.

Total Club registrations for the season stood at 595, 494 at first registration with 101 added during the season. This compares with 600 in 1997 a drop of just 5 - or 0.8%.

In conclusion I feel the season was very successful with some excellent racing and with the standard of rowing maintained. A small increase in overall entries (+0.5%) and a small drop in registration (-0.8%) is an indication of very little change and while we can't therefore claim a growth situation we have not seen a fall either and I feel we have maintained the status-quo and retain a strong base from which further growth of our sport can be achieved.

The Association Secretaries Report on the 42nd Southcoast Championship Regatta, Stithians Reservoir, Falmouth, Cornwall on Saturday, 19th September, 1998.

The forty-second Southcoast Championship Regatta was staged by Falmouth Rowing Club on behalf of the West of England ARA on Stithians Reservoir, near Falmouth, Cornwall. The 1800m course, with stake boat start, was almost certainly the fairest we have competed on in the West of England, arguably the fairest on the Southcoast - and while the facilities were limited, and the Regatta site was around twenty five minutes from the Town - the weather was very kind - and all the events were completed without serious incident. More wind - or heavy rain would certainly have made the venue less desirable. While the organisation of the event prior to the day left a little to be desired - with the usual poor communications we have come to expect from a West of England staged event and a breach of South Coast Rules with the distribution of Raffle Tickets for sale - the organisation on the day was to a high standard and I am unaware of any major problems although the usual number of crews missed their start through bad planning and boat allocation problems.

On such a fair course the racing was excellent with no serious disputes or offences committed - and the racing in the Championship events was of an exceptionally high standard. In the Men's Senior Fours for the Bidiford Bowl West of England representatives Greenbank Falmouth, with three previous winners on board, re-claimed the Trophy but were pushed hard by the Hants & Dorset Champions - the BTC A Crew who were closing at the finish but could not quite do enough. CARA representatives Herne Bay were third with the second Hants & Dorset representatives - the BTC C crew finishing in 5th place. In the Men's Junior Senior Championship event there was an expected win for the Hants & Dorset Champions from Christchurch - although they were pushed harder than expected by Herne Bay from the Coast. The Hants & Dorset's second representatives - from BTC were a very creditable third. The Men's Junior Championship race produced a win for Coast representatives Shoreham with Bidiford AAC in second and Hants & Dorset Champions, Southampton in third. The Hants & Dorset's second representatives again from BTC were fourth. The Ladies Senior Championship was retained by Worthing, representing the Coast ARA but they were pushed hard over the final stages by Southampton, the Hants & Dorset Champions. Exeter from the West of England were third and BTC, the Hants & Dorset's second crew finished 6th. The runners-up for the Hants & Dorset Championship - from Southsea - returned to their early season form to win the Ladies Junior Championship event from the two West of England representatives - Exeter who were second and Greenbank Falmouth who finished third. The Hants & Dorset Champions - Poole - finished fourth. The Hants & Dorset ARA's two Championship wins, two second places and a third were enough to give the Association the Bass' Aggregate shield - in an excellent all round performance from our representative crews. The disappointment of having not won the Bidiford Bowl for ten years remains a frustration.

The strength of the Hants & Dorset Clubs in comparison with the other two Associations was clearly demonstrated in the Open and Invitation events where our Associations Clubs dominated the entries and won over half the events. The only supporting events where we failed to have at least one crew in the first three was the Men's Open Senior Fours which was won by Shoreham from the Coast, followed by crews from West of England Clubs Torquay and Bidiford AAC. Shanklin from the Hants & Dorset, who surprisingly declined the opportunity to row-off for a Championship slot, won the Men's Invitation Junior Senior Event from another Hants & Dorset Club - the Vospers in second, Coast Club Herne

bay finishing third. Vosper again featured in the Men's Invitation Junior event which they won and which was dominated by Hants & Dorset Clubs with Southsea in second place and Westover third. The Hants & Dorset were equally dominant in the Men's Invitation Novice event were BTC won from Ryde in second and third place. A crew from Worthing, of whom there were some suspicions - as allegedly none had competed on the coast during the season - won the Ladies Open Senior event with Bidiford A. R. C in second and Hants & Dorset Club Christchurch in third. The Ladies invitation Junior Fours was won by Paignton, from the West of England with Hants & Dorset Clubs - BTC and Coalporters - in second and third. Finally the Ladies Invitation Novice event was again dominated by the the Hants & Dorset - Lymington winning from Westover in second and Ryde in third. With four wins, five seconds and five thirds in the open and invitation events there was no doubt that the Hants & Dorset ARA were the winners of the Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta Sesquicentennial Trophy.

In the Championship events the three Associations had full representation - with the exception of one of the Coast ARA crews in the Championship Ladies Junior Fours. In the invitation and Open events there were ninety-nine crews entered - 61 of these coming from Hants & Dorset Clubs - 62% of the entry. The Coast ARA had 19 crews entered - just 19% - and even more disturbingly the West of England ARA - the host Association also only had 19 entries. It is clear that without the support of the Hants & Dorset Clubs the Championships would be in a very sorry state and while the large entry from our Association in the open and invitation events helps our points total for the aggregate trophy - by winning both aggregate trophies we have clearly proved that we are the best of the three South Coast Rowing Associations.
