Association Secretaries Report on the 2001 Season.

Fifteen Championship Regatta's were planned for the 2001 season stretching from mid May, with Worthing Regatta through to the 1st September - just one week before the South Coast Championships - where the Hants & Dorset Regatta season concluded with BTC Regatta. If Clubs attended all the Regatta's and the National Championships there was just two free weekends between these dates - an intensive programme. Milford Regatta was postponed, due to the conditions but they were able to find a date later in the season and this event was successfully completed. Bournemouth were not so fortunate the Regatta being rightly abandoned, in worsening conditions after nine races and just three finals - with no alternative date available.

Four Regatta's had one hundred or more entries at entry closure date - Swanage, Bournemouth, Poole and Southsea - and it is safe to assume that another seven Regatta's - Ryde, BTC, Itchen, Coalporters, Milford, Shanklin and Woolston - with entries in the upper eighties and nineties will have exceeded one hundred entries when late entries are taken into account. Southsea, inevitably had the largest entry, combined as it is with CARA, of 146 - with Swanage on 108. Overall entries increased by 54 to a total of 1399 an increase of 4% over 2000 with 6 Regatta's showing a drop in entries and 9 an increase. These figures exclude non-championship events where we have seen a growth in Veteran's Racing and mixed events and the usual number of cadet races.

The Men's Senior Fours Championship was retained by the BTC Rowing Club in spite of there A crew having to serve a suspension for the first three Regatta's of the season. The crew finished the season with six wins and points including an impressive performance at Southsea where he CARA Senior crews were put firmly in their place. With the BTC crew also suspended from the South Coast Championship Hants & Dorset runners-up Coalporters, who had four wins during the season represented the Association, with Itchen Imperial, who had one win in the season, taking the second slot after winning a row-off against Ryde who had two wins and Lymington with one. Coalporters went on to win the South Coast Championships with Itchen second.

BTC also won the Men's Junior Senior Championship with eight wins the main challenge coming from a Ryde crew who's four wins gave them the runners-up position and representative honors at the South Coast Championships with BTC where the Champions were second and Ryde third. Coalporters and Worthing's Junior Senior crews won one Regatta each during the season but never really challenged the front-runners.

In the Men's Junior Fours Ryde and Poole were the early front-runners until new comers Bournemouth University mounted their challenge. The competition continued to the last Regatta with the big Bournemouth University. Crew taking the Championship with seven wins over the young Ryde crews five and Poole's two. Bournemouth, who beat Senior opposition to win the Coastal Coxless Fours at the National Championships, went on to win the South Coast Championship with Ryde Runners-up.

The competition in the Men's Novice Fours was better than it had been for some years with just two Regatta's failing to have sufficient entries and a much higher general

standard. Six Clubs had wins - Westover taking the Championship with three, Poole, Itchen, Southsea and Christchurch taking two wins each and Ryde gaining a single win.

Southampton totally dominated the Senior Ladies Fours winning all fourteen Regattas' with eleven points and the South Coast Championships. Itchen, Poole, Southsea and Coalporters mounted brief challenges the strongest coming from Coalporters who recorded nine second places and claimed the second South Coast Championship representative slot where they finished second behind the Hants & Dorset Champions.

The Junior Ladies Fours event was also dominated by one Club - BTC - but this time two crews were involved with the A and B Crew winning 12 Regatta's between them - the A Crew winning the Championship, and both crews representing the Association at the South Coast Championships where the B Crew won, with the A Crew second. Christchurch and Poole each won once to claim the remaining points.

In the Novice Ladies Fours the most obvious down side of the two wins before promotion rule was illustrated with six Clubs sharing the Championship with two wins each from Westover, Coalporters, Christchurch, BTC, Southampton and Bournemouth University.

The Men's Senior Pairs event was one of the most closely fought Championships with all the available points shared equally between two Clubs - Southsea and Lymington, who both finished the season with six wins and seven points apiece. The Championship was eventually decided on a row-off with Southsea taking the honors.

The Men's Junior Pairs suffered its share of controversy - with Christchurch, with four wins eventually emerging as Champions ahead of Bournemouth University, who also had four wins but only three points. The event was poorly supported which led to a number of events having no point awarded - Westover for example also won on four occasions but only claimed one point - and this was for being the highest finishing Hants & Dorset Crew at Southsea Regatta - not one of the events they won! Coalporters also recorded a single win.

The Ladies Senior Pairs was a reasonably closely contested contest between Southsea and Christchurch with Southsea emerging as Champions with seven wins against Christchurch's four. Southampton and Bournemouth University managing one win a piece.

Mick Gisborne of Southsea finally lost his grip on the Men's Senior Sculls Championship loosing out to Mike Horn of Christchurch after a row-off following their six wins apiece during the season. Jeff Watling of Southsea snatched a single win.

The Men's Junior Sculls Championship was dominated by Lee Rayment of Southampton who won nine races and claimed ten points, the only serious challenge coming from O'Brien of Westover with three wins and Wardell of BTC who won once.

Hauxwell of Christchurch took the Ladies Sculling Championship, with five wins, to complete a good performance in small boats by her Club. Hume of BTC and Stone of Bournemouth University challenged with two wins apiece.

Sarah Smith of Poole was the surprise winner of the Hants & Dorset Coxswain of the year Trophy.

[Individual registrations with Hants & Dorset Club in 2001 increased by 54 to a total of 660 an increase of 8.9%. This is close to, and an increase on the 1999 figure and is partly explained by the affiliation of an additional Club - Bournemouth University with 36 registered members - although some of these transferred from other Clubs. BTC were the largest Club with 90 rowing members registered - Coalporters were second with 80 and they also showed the largest increase.]

The 2001 season should be regarded as a successful one for the Association, There were no serious disciplinary incidents and the new rule allowing the Association to fine individuals who verbally abuse Officials was never invoked. An increase in entries of 4% [and of registrations of nearly 9%] is a very encouraging sign and the performance of the Associations representative crews and Clubs at the South Coast Championship's was outstanding. [While we can never afford to be complacent and as always there are many areas where we can and need to make improvements we should also be prepared to acknowledge when progress has been made and I believe the 2001 season can be regarded in this light.]

Association Secretary's Report on the 2001 South Coast Championship Regatta, held at Folkstone, Kent, hosted by CARA, dated 8th September, 2001.

The 45th South Coast Championships Rowing Regatta was staged at Folkestone, Kent, on Saturday, September 8th and organised on behalf of the host Association, the Coast ARA by the local Club.

The Regatta, so disrupted by bad weather in recent years badly needed a well-organised event with favourable weather conditions. The earlier than usual date, in place following a South Coast Council rule change stating that the Regatta must be held within the first two weeks of September, was designed to assist this aim. The initial signs were not that encouraging - the distribution of information prior to the event was very poor, the Official Programme, considering how long they had to produce it was very disappointing; the ridiculously early closing date for entries, seven weeks before the Regatta led, inevitably, to a very disrupted programme; and the weather forecast in the week leading up to the Regatta - and in practice on the Friday before the Regatta added to our growing fears. The early date of the Regatta, just one week after the last Hants & Dorset Regatta meant that we were unable to confirm the Championship representative crews until just six days before the event, and so the programme could only include a supplement sheet with these details - although this is a problem we will have to live with if we are to maintain the earlier date - which we must.

However on the day the wind settled and blew from a favourable direction and the organising committees carefully laid plans finally fell into place and, at least from my point of view, on the day, the Regatta ran very smoothly, with little or no problems.

The early closing date for entries, a problem that needs addressing, probably led to a reduced entry from at least the Hants & Dorset Clubs and certainly led to a higher than usual level of scratchings that led to a significant re-draw the day before the event with many heats abandoned or amalgamated. The early entry date was challenged by this Association the only concession being given being one to allow a later entry for promoted Novice Crews in the open Junior Events. Entries, including Championship races, when first published were 142, 67 from the Hants & Dorset (47%); 55 from the Coast (39%) and 20 from the West of England (14%). After the re-draw on the Friday evening, but excluding any further scratchings on the day the entry had dropped to 119 - 53 from the Hants & Dorset (44%), 52 from CARA (44%) and just 14 from the West of England (12%) - who also failed to provide their full contingent of representative crews - with only 1 crew in each Ladies event.

While congratulating CARA and Folkstone R. C. on a well run Regatta on the date it is true to say that the Hants and Dorset ARA dominated the racing with nine of the available thirteen Trophies and both Aggregate shield being won by Hants & Dorset Clubs.

In the Championship events no Hants & Dorset representative crew finished outside the top three places, a remarkable and possibly unmatched performance. In the first Championship race of the day the Mens Junior Fours, the Hants & Dorset Champions from Bournemouth University led the race from start to finish the only serious challenge coming in the first half of the race from the young Ryde Crew - the Hants &

Dorset ARA runnersup. These two crews finished comfortably 1st and 2nd with a 3 length gap between them and a further 3 lengths to the third placed crew from Bexhill. In th Ladies Junior Championship the two Hants & Dorset repretative crews, both from BTC, the Hants & Dorset Champions, agin finished first and second - and had their own private battle which saw the "B" crew turn the tables on the "A" crew to snatch victory in a very close race. CARA represntatives Herne Bay were third some way behind. The Mens Junior Senior Championship race was the only "disappointment" for the Hants & Dorset ARA, a strong CARA representative crew from Dover wining in some style, with Hants & Dorset Champions BTC second and runners-up Ryde in third - which was still a very strong performance. The Ladies Senior Fours was dominated, as the Hants & Dorset season had been by the Association Champions from Southampton, with another one, two for the Association as Coalporters finished in second place, with CARA representatives Deal in third. Finally in the Mens Senior Fours Championship Race for the Bidiford Bowl the Hants & Dorset ARA completed yet another first and second place, this in spite of the Hants & Dorset Champions being suspended and unable to compete. But the Associations selected represntatives certainly did not let their Clubs or their Association down with Coalporters finishing first and Itchen Imperial second to complete the Associations domination of the Championship events and secure the Bass Aggregate Shield with ease. Our congratulations are extended to the winning crews but all the Associations represntatives crews can feel very proud of their acheievements.

The Hants & Dorset ARA was almost as dominant in the Open and Invitation events. Shanklin won the Novice Ladies event with Worthing second and Poole third. There was a first and second place for the Association in the Men's Novice fours with Ryde first and BTC second. This was repeated in the Ladies Junior Fours with Westover first and Poole second and repeated agin in the Mens Junior Fours where BTC won from Shanklin; a fourth one two came in the Mens Junior Seniors where Shanklin beat Coalporters. In the new Veterans race Dover finished first in front of two Southsea Crews who finished second and third. In the Ladies Senior Fours Shoreham took the honours from Bexhill with Southampton in third and in the Mens Senior Fours a very suspect Bexhill crew just beat Ryde with Lymington in third. Five wins from, eight events with six second places and five thirds comfortably gave the Association the Open and Invitation events aggregate Trophy.

I am sure the Regatta will be remembered for the excellence of its organisation, the fine racing and the dominant performance of the Hants & Dorset ARA - the only disappointment being the poor communication prior to the day.
