The Association Secretaries Report on the 2002 Hants & Dorset ARA Season.

The Hants & Dorset ARA had planned a fifteen regatta championship programme for the 2002 season but early season events suffered from the weather with the first two Regatta's, Worthing, scheduled for the 18th May and Shanklin scheduled for the 25th May both cancelled. The first attempt to hold Milford Regatta, on 22nd June also resulted in cancellation. A second attempt to stage Worthing Regatta on the 30th June was also lost to the weather and with no other suitable dates available this Regatta was lost from the programme - however alternatives were found for Shanklin and Milford and a fourteen Regatta programme eventually completed.

The Men's Senior fours Championship was a closely contested affair with Lymington, BTC, Ryde and Itchen Imperial all recording wins in some excellent races. It was Lymington; however that emerged as the worthy Champions with a consistency of performance that resulted in seven wins. BTC mounted a late challenge to finish in the runners-up and gain South Coast Championship selection with five wins and Ryde and Itchen claimed one win each. Southampton and Coalporters also challenged and Christchurch gained a point for their success at the National Championships.

In contrast the Men's Junior Senior Fours was a very one-sided affair with the Christchurch crew, who won the National Championships Coastal fours event against Senior opposition, dominating and winning 13 races to claim 11 points - all the points that were awarded. The event suffered from a small entry with just three crews regularly competing and in three Regattas only two crews involved and no point awarded. It was in one of these - Milford - that Christchurch suffered their only defeat at Junior Senior - the Ryde snatching a win. Over the season the BTC crew was consistently second and they rowed off against Ryde to claim the 2nd South Coast Championships second Representative slot alongside Christchurch. Christchurch went on to win the South Coast Championships event, in spite of a challenge from the Coast regarding their eligibility following their National wins that was dismissed by the South Coast Council.

The performance of the Championship winning crew in the Men's Junior Fours was even more dominating the BTC crew taking all 14 available Championship points, their only defeat coming at Southsea where they finished 2nd to Coast ARA Club Deal. They turned the tables at the South Coast Championships winning with comparative ease. Westover, Ryde, Shanklin, Itchen Imperial and Coalporters all had crews that challenged BTC's dominance without success with Westover, Ryde and Shanklin taking 2nd places but surprisingly only Ryde were interested in the honor of representing their Association at the South Coast Championships.

The Men's Novice fours Championships saw wins for seven Clubs during the season - BTC, Ryde, Coalporters, Southampton, Westover and Poole. with BTC emerging as the Champions with four wins from Ryde with three. Coalporters and Southampton had two wins apiece the others taking a single win. Points were awarded in all fourteen events, heats required in most, and the standard of the crew, at least in the early part of the season showed an improvement on recent years.

The Ladies Senior Fours Championship was one of the most closely contested with three crews - Poole, BTC and Coalporters - in the frame for most of the season. Poole, the eventual Champions, started strongly, achieving six wins, but lost their form near the end of the season. BTC mounted a strong challenge from mid-season gaining five wins and may well have overhauled Poole but for the improving Coalporters crew who eventually won on three occasions. Poole, as Champions and BTC as runners-up represented the Association at the South Coast Championships Regatta with BTC turning the tables on their rivals to win the event.

Westover dominated the sometimes poorly supported Ladies Junior Fours event winning on eight occasions the only serious challenge coming from Coalporters who won twice. with BTC and Ryde mounting a lesser challenge. On two occasions there were insufficient crews competing for points to be awarded. Westover and Coalporters went on to represent the Association at the South Coast Championships - Westover proving to be worthy Champions by winning once again.

The Novice Ladies Fours Championship illustrated the down side of the two wins before promotion to Junior system - with, for the second year running no Club managing to win more than twice. Seven Clubs therefore shared the Championships - Itchen Imperial, Christchurch, BTC, Lymington, Westover, Poole and Shanklin.

The Men's Senior Pairs was also poorly supported with one Regatta having no entries and another three insufficient entries to justify a point. Where a point was awarded Lymington dominated taking eight points and the Championship. Itchen Imperial won three races but only one point and Worthing gained the point awarded for the Coastal event at the National Championships.

The Men's Junior pairs also suffered from poor support - one Regatta with no entries and another two with no point awarded. But the competition was closer Southampton winning the Championship with seven points from nine wins from Southsea with three wins and points.

In contrast the Ladies Pairs event was better supported and produced a very close championship which was not decided until the very last Regatta. Itchen Imperial winning six events to just take the Championship from Southampton with five. Christchurch challenged briefly and won on occasions.

The Men's Senior Sculls title was regained by Mick Gisborne of Southsea who won five races and picked up the point at Southsea. His nearest challenger was O'Brien from Westover with three wins - Pearce of Coalporters picking up the point awarded at the National Championships.

Critchley of Christchurch secured the Men's Junior Sculls title winning seven times during the season. There were some very close Junior sculls races with several others mounting a challenge to Critchley - notably Kier of Lymington, with four wins and Burch of Shanklin with a single win on home waters.

The Ladies Sculling title also went to a Christchurch Sculler - Liz Hauxwell claiming four points in an event that did not really get going until mid season. Her nearest rival was Hume of BTC who won twice but was only able to claim one point.

The BTC Champion Junior Four Coxswain - Andrea Richards, justifiably won the Hants & Dorset Coxswain of the year Trophy, having hardly put a foot wrong all season.

Once again BTC emerged as the top performing Club with 31 wins, closely followed by Christchurch with 29 wins with Lymington in third with 21.

Men's Junior Senior Fours – BTC v Ryde for 2nd Hants & Dorset ARA Representative slot at the South Coast Championships Regatta, at Torbay, on 14th September, 2002.

BTC beat Ryde by 1 length and were therefore awarded the 2nd representative slot.

Association Secretary's Report on the 2002 South Coast Championship Regatta, held at Paignton, Torbay, Devon, hosted by the West of England ARA, dated 14th September 2002.

The 46th South Coast Championships Rowing Regatta was scheduled to be staged at Paignton, Torbay, Devon on Saturday, September 14th and organized on behalf of the host Association, the West of England ARA by the local Clubs - Paignton and Torquay.

In spite of the fact that these two Clubs run successful Regattas in Torbay each year as part of the West of England Regatta Programme there was considerable concern expressed by Hants & Dorset Clubs regarding the choice of venue and the possibility of inclement weather making conditions un-rowable - especially in River Boats. It is most unfortunate that this concern proved to be well founded as the conditions and wind direction throughout the weekend of the Championships made all the Torbay courses unusable. The council meeting at 7.00am on the morning of the Regatta confirmed our worst fears - the Paignton course was un-rowable and the decision was taken to delay the start to 2.00pm, from 11.00am and try to stage the Regatta on the Torquay course. Clubs were briefed at 9.00am and the Clubs moved to Torquay and waited for the Council meeting planned for 1.00pm to pronounce judgment - although to almost everyone the outcome was inevitable. At 1.00pm the South Coast Council confirmed that the Regatta was postponed and that, with the forecast for the Sunday, just as bad the Regatta would now be staged at Dartmouth, with the five championship events guaranteed and hopefully a full programme of events possible - which was to be confirmed at 6.00pm that evening. There is some confusion as to weather approval for the use of the Dartmouth course was in place - it probably was for the Championship events - and it is to the credit of the organizers that they were able to extend this approval for the open events as we, all be it over a reduced 1000m course - with the Championship events raced over the full 2000m.

The Men's Senior Fours Championship event was won by Bexhill for the Coast ARA in a tight race with Lymington, the Hants & Dorset Champions chasing them all the way to be line and so nearly catching them. A protest followed with Lymington claiming they were pushed over and squeezed out by Bexhill - which it is difficult for me to pass comment on and I have to accept that the Umpires decision to let the race stand is the correct one. I also have some concern about the format of the Bexhill Crew and while not suggesting any irregularity in the CARA registration system I suspect that all this crew did not start the season racing for Bexhill! West of England representatives Torquay finished 3rd with the second coast representatives Dover in 4th, BTC representing the Hants & Dorset in 5th and Bidiford Blues from the West of England 6th.

The race for the Bidiford Bowl proved to be the only disappointment for the Hants & Dorset ARA in the Championship races as the Associations representative crews confirmed their dominance of the past few years.

The Christchurch Junior Senior Crew, the Hants & Dorset Champions, having overcome a pathetic attempt by the Coast ARA to have them thrown out of the Championships, which was easily defeated by the Hants & Dorset and West of England ARA, won their Championship race with comparative ease although they left their final push until quite late in the day. Dart Totnes A representing the West of England finished second, with Coast representatives Herne Bay and Bexhill 3rd and 4th, Dart Totnes from the West of England 5th and the second Hants & Dorset crew from BTC 6th.

The Hants & Dorset Men's Junior Champions from BTC also won with some ease defeating the Coast Champions - Deal to reverse their defeat at Southsea Regatta - the only Junior race this crew lost all season. West of England representatives Exeter finished 3rd, with the other Coast representatives Folkestone in 4th. Ryde representing the Hants & Dorset and Bidiford Blues representing the West of England failed to finish after being washed down and swamped by a passing safety boat!

The Senior Ladies Championship was the only event where the Hants & Dorset's second string turned the tables on the Association Champions - BTC winning a close race with Champions Poole in second. Falmouth and Dart Totnes the West of England representatives were 3rd and 4th with the Coast representatives Herne Bay 5th. Their other representatives Folkestone did not finish.

The Westover Junior Ladies crew and Hants & Dorset Champions could have been knocked of course by the decision to stop their race when leading and to re-row but they took the incident in their stride and won the re-row just as convincingly with Bidiford Reds and Exeter, from the West of England 2nd and 3rd, the other Hants & Dorset representatives Coalporters 4th and Coast Representatives Dover and Folkestone 5th and 6th respectively.

The Hants & Dorset ARA's four Championship winning performances and the support of the Associations other representative crews easily won the Association the Bass Aggregate Shied for the 5th consecutive year and the 7th in the last ten years, which BTC will hold on behalf of the Association for their two Championship wins.

Hants & Dorset ARA crews also dominated the supporting events winning seven of the eight events. In the Men's Senior Fours Ryde won after a re-row called because of an incident at the start that should have stopped the race at that point. Itchen Imperial were second with Deal third. The men's Junior Seniors saw a second win for Ryde in a very close race finish with Shanklin with Torquay third. The Men's Junior coxed fours saw Coalporters win with Deal 2nd and Bexhill 3rd and in the Men's Novice Coxed fours the Hants & Dorset claimed the top three paces - Westover winning from Bournemouth University in second and Ryde in third. Coalporters won the Ladies Senior event with Falmouth 2nd and Poole 3rd and the Ladies Junior Fours gave Ryde their 3rd victory of the day with Torquay second and Exeter 3rd. The Ladies Novice Fours was the only supporting event the Hants & Dorset ARA did not win with Deal finishing first from Paignton in second and Poole 3rd. The Veteran Fours gave BTC a third win to go with their two championship successes with Bidiford Blues in second and Shoreham 3rd. Ryde's three wins gave them the aggregate trophy for the supporting events.

Entries for the Regatta were 116, 86 of which were in the supporting events. 53 of the entries came from Hants & Dorset Clubs, around 46% of the total entry with the West of England with 32 entries and the Coast ARA 31 - around 27% each.

While praising the organizers for the well planned and executed switch of the event to Dartmouth and the organization of the Regatta on that day there were a number of aspects of the events organization that were less praise worthy. Communications before the Regatta were very poor - most Clubs only receiving the initial invitation and then a single sheet during the last week indicating the order of events. There was no information available on the alternative courses, trailer-parking arrangements or, prior to the Friday evening when programmes went on sale, any details of the races - which is critical information when Clubs are trying to borrow River Boats.

The attitude of the Coast ARA added further complications - the attempt to disqualify Christchurch Junior Seniors, their insistence on all the supporting events taking place which I understand compromised the possibility of Dartmouth as an alternative venue and the strange insistence on allowing Coastal boats to be used in the supporting events when quite clearly if conditions prevented the use of River Boats the Regatta would be cancelled.

The 46th South Coast Rowing Championships will be regarded as successful, with the full programme of events completed and some excellent racing, But question marks remain over the venues available to all three Associations and serious consideration should be given to the possibility of using an inland, purpose built course, that will guarantee the successful completion of the Regatta in a safe and fair environment.

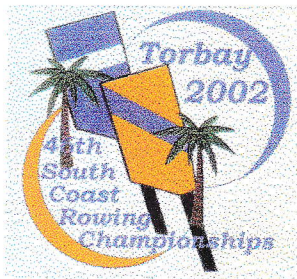
