The Association Secretaries Report on the 2003 Hants & Dorset ARA Season.

A fifteen regatta programme was planned for the Hants & Dorset Amateur Rowing Associations Centenary season - the year marking the one hundredth anniversary of the split from the Coast ARA to form an Association focused on administering Coastal rowing in Hampshire, Dorset and the Isle of Wight.

The reasonably fine weather led to a minimum of disruption to the programme with only Worthing, for the second year in succession, failing to successfully stage their Regatta in spite of two attempts. There were a few events staged in rough conditions but in the main it was an unusually calm series of Regattas which may have had some impact on the results.

Entries to all Regattas (excluding late entries) were down from the 2002 season total of 1356 to 1323 a drop of just 23 - less than 2% - which could arguably be explained by a rare event - Southampton reaching the F. A. Cup Final played on the IW Regatta weekend, which saw a drop of over thirty entries to the two Regattas over the previous year. Four Regattas - Bournemouth, BTC, Swanage and Southsea exceeded one hundred entries. Subject to appeal twenty fines were imposed for late scratchings during the season – but happily none for abuse of Racing Officials or bringing the sport into disrepute.

Registrations across the fourteen affiliated Clubs where 598 - 498 at first registration with 100 added during the season. This compares with 623 in 2002 a drop of 25 or around 4%. The largest Club is Poole with Coalporters second who both exceeded 70 registrations.

There can seldom have been a season in the Associations one hundred year history where one Club has so dominated the fours events, especially in the early part of the season, BTC winning 49 - nearly half - of the 112 fours events contested.

In the Men's Senior Fours the BTC crew won on twelve occasions including Southsea against CARA opposition. Intriguingly the only races they lost were the first and last Regatta's of the season, both won by Ryde who provided the most consistent challenge to BTC's dominance with Itchen, Coalporters and Lymington also featuring. BTC and Ryde went on to represent the Association at the South Coast Championships - with BTC crowning a great season by taking the Bideford Bowl with Ryde 2nd.

The Men's Junior Senior Fours produced an equally dominating display by the BTC Club their crew also winning on twelve occasions - their only defeat being on the short Poole course where the home club snatched victory. Ryde won a non-status, no point, race against Shanklin at Newport Regatta. BTC and Poole went on to represent the Association at the South Coast Championships where BTC finished 2nd.

BTC also won the Men's Junior Fours Championship but this time did not have it all their own way with a very strong challenge from a Christchurch Crew only promoted from Novice status at the beginning of the season. BTC eventually won by the closest of margins - just one point - taking points at seven Regattas against six for Christchurch. A crew from Coalporters, who challenged the top two all season took the other point and BTC and Christchurch went on to represent the Association at the

South Coast Championships where Christchurch reversed the position to finish second with BTC in third.

In the Men's Novice Fours four Clubs shared the Championship with two points each - Ryde, Coalporters, BTC and Christchurch. Southsea gained one point and had a second win with no point where there were insufficient entries - a fate that also befell Ryde on one occasion. Bournemouth University had a win withdrawn for fielding illegible crew members and lost a point due to unregistered oarsman - a problem that also lost them a point in the Novice Ladies Fours.

Southampton convincingly won the Ladies Senior Fours Championship with twelve wins and eleven points the only other point being awarded to Poole for a win in Southampton's absence. Southampton went on to represent the Association and win at the South Coast Championship but controversy dogged the second representative slot - Poole Senior Ladies surprisingly and disappointingly declining the Associations invitation to represent them - although they were happy to compete in the open event. In contrast it is to the credit of Itchen, Coalporters, BTC and Lymington that in spite of very clearly being the under dogs they were all prepared to accept the honour of representing the Association - Itchen who were 3rd in the Hants & Dorset Championship taking up the challenge.

Yet another dominating display in the Ladies Junior Fours saw BTC win yet another Association Championship with twelve points from thirteen wins, using two different crews - who both went on to represent the Association at the South Coast Championships where they finished first and third. Only Christchurch mounted a serious challenge taking one point.

With four wins in the last five Regattas and four points gained *(one lost for an unregistered oarswoman)* Coalporters snatched the Novice Ladies Championship, with Southampton, Westover and Christchurch each with two wins in the runners-up position. Ryde and Southsea also had single Ladies Novice wins.

In the Men's Senior Pairs Lymington retained the Championship with a convincing twelve points and eleven wins. Southampton mounted the most serious challenge to their dominance but failed to get a win - Southsea being the only other Club to take a point.

The Men's Junior Pairs suffered from low entries with Ryde gaining only two points from their five wins - Christchurch rightly claiming the Championship with six points from seven wins.

Half of the Championship winning Ladies Senior Four continued their dominance in the Ladies Senior Pairs winning twelve races and taking nine points with Lymington the only other Club to win.

The Men's Senior Sculls was a closely fought contest with six different scullers winning. Gisborne of Southsea emerged as the Champion with four wins and five points just beating Ingle of Coalporters with three wins and points. O'Brien of Westover won twice and Mahoney and Tout of Southsea and Pike of Ryde all recorded single wins.

The Men's Junior Sculls was an even closer competition although only one Club was involved. The Championship was not decided until the last Regatta of the season when Maitland of Ryde taking the point in the last five Regattas to pip his Club rival Jenner who had four points from six wins.

Ryde produced another dominant performance in the newly introduced Men's Novice Single Sculls event. Ryde Scullers won seven of the thirteen races including Maitland and Jenner who went on to win at Junior Sculls and Salter and Allsopp who also achieved the two wins necessary to move up to Junior status as did Seward of Coalporters and Foad of Itchen, Johnson of Southampton won once. Ryde's Ashley Maitland has the unique distinction of being the Hants & Dorset ARA's first Junior Sculler to have earned his status through Novice wins.

In complete contrast to the Men's Sculling events - Ladies single sculling - and the newly introduced Ladies Junior sculls suffered from very disappointing entries all season. The Senior Championship was won by Kay Hume of BTC who won three of the five races staged but gained only one point. Bagwell of Christchurch won the remaining two races and also only won one point but unfortunately was injured and unable to compete in the row-off handing the Championship to Hume.

Eight races were held in the Ladies Junior sculls but only three points awarded - the Championship deservedly going to Creswell of Christchurch who won seven races for two points with Lane of Lymington winning once for one point. One encouraging sign is that eight Ladies Junior scullers competed during the season - but there was seldom more than two in a race.

But to end on a happier note the third new Championship event introduced - the Veteran Coxed Fours – was a great success and often had the largest entry at the Regatta. It was also a close contest with four different Clubs winning Southampton's six wins and points eventually making them the first Hants & Dorset ARA Veterans Fours Champions. BTC were runners-up with four wins and points, Southsea were third with three and Poole won on one occasion.

As the Association enters its second centaury there are certainly areas of concernnotably the continued fall in Regatta entries and Club Registrations and the failure of
Ladies sculling to generate much interest at present. However there are equally some
ground for optimism - The introduction of Men's Novice Sculls and Championship
Veteran Fours was without doubt a success and the increasing activity involving
cadets in many Clubs is an excellent sign. The Association needs to continue to
embrace new and radical ideas and be prepared to try them out - some will succeed,
some will fail - but we must push forward with new ideas to secure the future of
Coastal Rowing and the Hants and Dorset Amateur Rowing Association.

Association Secretary's Report on the 2003 South Coast Championship Regatta, held at Swanage, Dorset and hosted by the Hants & Dorset ARA, dated 13th September 2003.

The Hants & Dorset ARA, fittingly in their Centenary Year, had the responsibility for staging the 47th South Coast Championships Regatta with Swanage in Dorset the chosen venue with an alternative course at Brambles Bay, near Studland, in Poole Harbour. A local committee chaired by Kevin Ayles organised the event on behalf of the Association.

After a slow start with the preparations that caused some concern for the Association's Executive Officers and South Coast Council delegates the committee got into its swing. Memories of 1999, when the high winds forced the abandonment of the Regatta at Swanage and the switch to the alternative course in Poole harbour for the Championship events, only on the Sunday was in peoples mind as the week of the regatta approached - the one area an otherwise efficient organisation could do nothing about. Clear skies and calm waters prevailed all week - but inevitably by Friday the wind had increased and Saturday dawned with rough but rowable conditions which improved during the day - the use of the first choice course, thankfully never being in doubt. The only significant issue at the Regatta morning council meeting was a debate instigated by CARA over Poole Senior Ladies decision to decline an invitation to represent their Association – but as this was seen as a matter for the Association the agreed action was to ask Poole to withdraw the crew from the open event – an option they declined.

On the Friday evening an excellent reception had been staged in the Regatta Marquee which was pretty much open to all and included the Championship draw and a presentation to all competing Clubs and Officials of a Hants & Dorset ARA centenary souvenir in the form of a small badge or brooch of the Associations crest. In the preceding few weeks competing Clubs and Officials had received, in contrast to the last few years, an information package that included the draw, rules, safety information, accommodation and details of the location and manning of the support boats - and the impressive Regatta programme was available at the reception along with the usual Regatta merchandise. Much of this information was also circulated in advance by electronic mail and a Championship Web site also provided early access to the details of the regatta for those with access to the internet.

One hundred and twenty-five crews were entered for the Championships - twenty-nine for the Championship events, ninety six in the open. The Hants and Dorset ARA accounted for seventy-five of these - around 60%. The Coast had entries from thirty-eight crews, around 30% and the West of England crews made up the other 10% - just twelve crews, a very disappointing figure that questions the West of England ARA Clubs commitment to this event and threatens its future. In contrast the atmosphere on the beach as the Regatta got underway was excellent and the support enthusiastic - especially for the Championship races.

In the first Championship event – the Men's Junior Fours - the Deal crew, representing the Coast ARA, won with some style pushing the two Hants & Dorset

representative crews into 2nd and 3rd place with Christchurch beating the Hants & Dorset Champions from BTC.

But In the Ladies Junior Fours Championship event the Hants & Dorset representative crews, who both came from the BTC Club, avenged this defeat finishing first and third the BTC A Crew pushing West of England representatives Dartmouth into second place, rowing through them on the line.

The Hants & Dorset ARA won their second Championship event – the Ladies Senior Fours - when the Association Champions from Southampton clinched a comfortable victory from CARA representatives Dover in second and West of England representatives Exeter in third. The Hants & Dorset second representative crew from Itchen Imperial where a late selection following Poole's decision to decline the invitation and although they finished in 5th place their attitude and willingness to represent their Association is to be applauded.

The Men's Junior Senior Fours Championship event arguably produced the most surprising result of the day with CARA representatives Folkestone winning from prerace favorites and Hants & Dorset Champions BTC who finished 2nd with the other CARA representatives from Deal in third place. The second Hants & Dorset representatives from Poole finished in 5th place. The winning Folkestone crew rode their luck in this event with a boat breakage on the way to the start that they were given time to return to repair. In this had happened just a few minutes later the event would have been underway and their race lost. The mishap did delay the start of the Junior Senior Championship race and played a significant part in the delayed finish of the Regatta. Unusually the winning Men's Junior Championship crew from Deal, with just one change, also represented CARA in this event.

And so to the Men's Senior Fours Championship event – with the position - two wins a piece for the Hants & Dorset and CARA from the other Championship events. But the Hants & Dorset ARA representatives crews - Champions BTC and the runners-up from Ryde did not let their Association down finishing first and second respectively with a convincing performance, from CARA representatives Deal in 3rd, to secure the Bass Charrington Aggregate Shield for the Association once again, with 26 points, against CARA with 15 and the West of England with 4.

Thirteen crews contested the Men's Open Senior event with four crews from Hants & Dorset Clubs and three from CARA Clubs contesting the final. The CARA Clubs Bexhill and Shoreham finishing 1st and 2nd from H&D Crew Itchen in 3rd.

In the Men's Junior Senior event nine crews raced, three from CARA Clubs and six from the Hants & Dorset with the host Association dominating the final with five of the six crews - and the first three to finish - Westover winning from Coalporters in second with Ryde third.

Eleven crews competed in the Men's Junior Fours with three H&D and four CARA Clubs reaching the final with Dover, from CARA claiming first place from H&D Clubs Ryde and Westover.

Twelve crews contested the Men's Novice Final, eight from the Hants & Dorset and four from CARA with three from each making the final which was dominated by the Hants & Dorset Crews - Poole winning from Itchen, with CARA Club Dover in third place.

The Veterans fours race, illustrating how popular this event has become, had the largest entry of the day with seventeen crews racing in three heats. Southsea maintained the Hants & Dorset ARA's good performance winning from CARA Clubs Bexhill in second and Folkestone in third.

The Ladies Senior Fours was the only straight final in the open events - Poole winning the eight boat race with Exeter from the West of England pushing the Hants & Dorset crew from Lymington into 3rd - the best performance from the few West of England crews to contest the open events.

Ten crew's contested two heats in the Junior Ladies event with the Hants & Dorset dominating the final with Christchurch crews finishing 1st and 3rd, split by Lymington in second.

Ten crews also contested the Ladies Novice fours with five Hants & Dorset crews and one crew from CARA making up the final which was once again won by a Hants & Dorset Club - Southsea with CARA Club Dover second and another Hants & Dorset Club - Ryde - in third.

The Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta Sesquicentennial Trophy for the most successful club in open events was shared by two Hants & Dorset Clubs - Southsea and Poole who each had ten points. I suppose the Coast may argue, in an effort to improve their standing, that as Southsea are affiliated to both associations they have a share in this - but I think that most of us regard Southsea as primarily a Hants & Dorset Club - and Worthing as primarily a Coast Club - and that is certainly the view I take when reporting on these events.

So, without being to complacent, the Hants & Dorset ARA won three of the five Championship events - including the Bidiford Bowl - six of the eight open events and both aggregate shields - we clearly remain the top Association. The Association, with our grateful thanks to the organising committee, hosted an excellent Regatta, which went off at the first attempt on the primary course in reasonable conditions and without any major controversy. A job well done and a fitting end to the Hants & Dorset Amateur Rowing Associations Centenary season.
