## **Hants & Dorset ARA.**

### **The Associations Secretaries Report on the 2004 Season.**

All but one of the fifteen scheduled Championship Regattas in the Hants & Dorset ARA's 2004 season were successfully completed the exception being Southsea, abandoned after four finals in steadily deteriorating conditions.

Although the crews were slightly different the main contenders for the Men's Senior Fours Championship came from the same two Clubs as last year with the same result - BTC's 12 wins plus the point from the Nationals allowing them to comfortably retain the Championship - Ryde's 2 wins and ten second places making them runners-up again. These two crews went on to represent the Association at the South Coast Championships - finishing 2nd and 3rd respectively.

The Men's Junior Senior fours lacked numbers with only seven of the twelve events having the required number of participants for a Championship point to be awarded, These races were dominated by a very good Christchurch crew who won them all - plus three of the non-Championship events - with Ryde and Poole each securing one win. Christchurch went on to represent the Association and win at the South Coast with BTC, who had been consistently second during the season finishing third and Ryde winning the open.

In contrast the Men's Junior Fours was a closely fought contest with Westover and Christchurch battling it out through the season with Westover emerging as Champions with seven wins and points against Christchurch with five. Itchen Imperial also challenged - winning once and gaining seven second places. Westover went on to win the South Coast Championships - with Christchurch the other Hants & Dorset representatives in third.

The quality of the Men's Novice Fours showed an improvement over the last few years with crews from five different Clubs securing wins. The Championship was shared between Poole and Coalporters who each had four wins. Itchen achieving three and BTC and Christchurch two each.

There was a dominating performance in the Ladies Senior Fours with Coalporters ten wins and eight points securing them the Championship. A late challenge from BTC, who won on two occasions briefly, threatened Coalporters dominance. These two crews went on to represent the Association at the South Coast - Coalporters finishing third and BTC 5th in a controversial race.

Coalporters proved their strength in depth in Ladies rowing as they also won the Ladies Junior Fours Championship - but this was a much closer contest with Southsea the early front runners. They ended the season with six points each forcing a row-off at Dock head - which Coalporters won. These two Crews represented the Association at the South Coast - with the Champions winning and Southsea finishing second. Christchurch challenged briefly securing one win during the season - and taking the open at the South Coast Championships.

The Ladies Novice standard also showed an improvement on previous years with wins coming from six different Clubs. Poole's four wins gave them the Championship with Christchurch, with three wins close behind. BTC and Coalporters secured two wins each and Itchen and Southsea had single wins. Lymington won the open event at the South Coast Championships.

In the Veteran Fours Southsea, with six wins emerged as Champions with BTC and Christchurch, with three wins each and Poole with two wins the main challengers. Southsea and BTC went on to represent the Association at the South Coast in the first Veteran Fours event to have full South Coast Championship status, but the result was disappointing Southsea finishing 4th and BTC 5th - but as some compensation Christchurch won the open.

Lymington's Kier and Lock retained their Men's Senior Pairs Championship convincingly with twelve wins from thirteen Regattas - Itchen taking the other point.

The Men's Junior Pairs suffered again from low entries Westover emerging as Champions with four points from five wins. Coalporters also managed five wins - but only two points with Christchurch and Itchen taking a point each.

The Ladies Senior Pairs was a close contest with Southampton retaining their Championship with seven wins over Christchurch with five - and Coalporters picking up a single point.

There was another close contest for the Men's Senior Sculls Title with three scullers in contention - Pike of Ryde taking the Championship with seven wins from Hume of BTC with four and reigning Champion Gisborne of Southsea with three.

There was an even closer contest in the men's Junior sculls with four scullers involved - Foad of Itchen's five points gave him the Championship with Cure of Westover just behind on four points, Allsopp of Ryde on three and Johnson of Southampton on two.

Two winning scullers from Christchurch, giving them four points, secured the Men's Novice Sculls Championship in a well supported event - where another seven scullers, from six different clubs recorded wins.

Ladies Sculling continues to struggle with the nine Senior events held producing just one race with sufficient entries to award a Championship point - Bagnell of Christchurch claiming the prize - and in the Junior Sculls no points and therefore no Championship was awarded.

However Ladies Novice Sculls, introduced this season, is more encouraging with six different scullers winning - the Championship going to Southsea with their three wins - Lymington, Christchurch, Southampton and Coalporters also recording wins.

The best performing Club was Christchurch with forty-one wins, Coalporters were second with thirty and Southsea third with twenty-nine.

Tom Clark, the Ryde Senior Four coxswain, who also steered the Southsea Ladies Junior Four for much of the season, was Hants & Dorset Cox of the year - decided for the first time by nominations from the Regatta Racing Officials. Thirteen coxswains, from nine different Clubs received nominations it what was I believe a much-improved system.

Some will be surprised to learn that, excluding Southsea - because entries come from both Associations - Regatta entries were 1184 - just 4 down on the 2003 season. Analysis is difficult as the figures show no real pattern - with six Regattas showing an increase in entries, and eight a fall. Strangely Bournemouth and Christchurch were significantly lower - Coalporters and Poole significantly higher! Four Regattas topped one hundred entries - Swanage, Itchen, Coalporters and Poole - in addition to Southsea. There is, I suspect, although I don't have the historical data to confirm it, a move away from fours to small boats and much more doubling-up as a result of the increased events and relaxation of the rules - which did give us some problems. The Southsea entry was 201 with the split between Hants & Dorset and CARA roughly equal

Registrations, at 570 showed a drop of 18 from the previous year - at least partially explained by Bournemouth University - who registered 24 in 2003 but none in 2004. 448 names were recorded at first registration with 122 added during the season. 379 - 66% were men, 191 - 34 % women.

In conclusion I feel I have reported on a reasonably successful season with some excellent racing although the fall in entries and registrations, however slight, is and should be of real concern. This Association and Coastal Rowing faces many challenges and we must be prepared to change and experiment with new ideas if we are to reverse recent trends and see a return to growth in our version of the sport.

***Hants & Dorset ARA.***

**Association Secretary's Report on the 2004 South Coast Championship Regatta, held at Bidiford, North Devon and hosted by the West of England ARA, dated 11th September 2004.**

Bidiford, North Devon was the chosen venue for the 48th South Coast Championship Regatta, hosted by the West of England ARA and organised by a committee from the two local Clubs. The planned start time of 3.00pm and the lack of a viable alternative course led to early concerns that the lack of information about the Regatta did nothing to alleviate. In an age of instant electronic communication the lack of a dedicated web site and an E Mail address was surprising - the single side of an A4 sheet sent to Clubs giving limited entry information was disgraceful. While Clubs eventually received a little more information - running order, basic map of course and limited safety and launch instructions there was no information about accommodation, pre-regatta training, trailer parking and a host of other basic requirements. The Programme - when available added little to the information received. The reception and Championship draw was held at the Town Hall on the Friday evening with restricted attendance - but was still over crowded and uncomfortable. The quay at Bidiford, which served, as the boat park and launch and recovery area was also very over crowded - hampered by construction work and a fair. The overcrowding made it dangerous and there was no system in place to control the movements and storage of boats and equipment. The launch and recovery area worked better and had a degree of marshalling. The designated boat safety checks were apparently carried out although I must confess I did not witness any. No allowance in the time table appeared to have been made for the arrival of the Lundy Ferry - which would have delayed an already tight programme had the weather not already done so - the Regatta being suspended for around forty-five minutes following at least three sinkings over two events in the gusting winds and torrential rain around half way through the Regatta. In spite of the pressure this put on the time-table this was a good call as the conditions settled allowing the Regatta to be completed - although very late and with the last few races in near darkness with a high risk of running out of water - which was also a significant safety concern.

The apparent use of the men's Junior Fours Championship race over a shortened 1200m course to test the conditions following the suspension of racing was a very poor decision - an open heat - the Veteran Fours, the next scheduled race should have been used rather than one of the Regatta's most important events. Equally I was surprised that the remaining Championship races were not held, one after the other after the re-start to ensure their completion in what were clearly dubious conditions. The delay to the Championship races, which conflict with South Coast Council Rules, could have had an impact on the results.

Entries for the Regatta were 116 - with 35 in the Championship events where the host Association failed to select two representatives in the Veteran Fours. In the open events there were 81 entries, over half - 41 - coming from Hants & Dorset Clubs - CARA having 27 entries and the West of England a pathetic 13.

BTC, Hants & Dorset Champions, just failed to retain the Bidiford Bowl in the Men's Senior Fours Championship event, losing by just one foot to CARA representatives

Shoreham who snatched victory on the line following a closely fought race involving these two crews, plus the second Hants & Dorset representatives Ryde - who all led at various stages in the race, Ryde eventually finishing in third less than a length behind Shoreham and BTC.

The Men's Junior Senior Fours Championship was the last Championship event of the day and was raced in near darkness and produced the expected victory for Hants & Dorset Champions Christchurch, although once again by the narrowest of margins from CARA representatives Deal. The second Hants & Dorset representatives - BTC - performed well to finish third.

Hants & Dorset Champions Westover won the Men's Junior Fours Championship event their three length win all the more impressive over the shortened 1200m course. Christchurch led briefly early in the race and finished second to give the Hants & Dorset a one, two in this event. CARA representatives Deal finishing in 3rd.

The Senior Ladies Championship event was won by an Exeter Crew that in my view should quite simply not have been allowed to compete, as they clearly did not meet the qualification rules having not competed in the appropriate number of events. Surprisingly the South Coast Council in their deliberations prior to the event accepted their entry - I have no doubt that had this been a Hants & Dorset Crew the decision would have been very different. Dart-Totnes were second in this event - with some doubts expressed about them meeting the qualification criteria. The Hants & Dorset Champions Coalporters finished 3rd - with BTC 4th - both admittedly beaten by better crews on the day - but had the South Coast rules been upheld this could have been a very different result.

In the Ladies Junior Fours Championship the Hants & Dorset dominated with H&D Champions Coalporters winning by two lengths from runners-up Southsea, who led at one stage of the race. The Coalporters win was an outstanding achievement for a crew that started the Season as Novices. Folkestone from CARA finished 3rd.

The Veteran Fours was a disappointment for the Hants & Dorset with our representatives finishing 4th and 5th behind Folkestone, Bidiford Blues and Bexhill - the West of England, the host Association having failed to come up with a second representative crew.

However the Associations three wins, three second places and three thirds in the Championship races was enough for the Association to secure the bass Charrington Aggregates Shield once again as top Association.

In the open events Hants & Dorset crew won four events, were second in five and third in three. The Open Seniors was won by a very strong Bexhill crew with Ryde second. Ryde won the Junior Seniors Open Fours, in near darkness, with Poole third. Herne Bay won the men's Junior Fours with Itchen Imperial in second - and they also finished second in the Men's Novice Fours event won by Bidford Blues. The Ladies Senior Fours open saw a win for the Bidford Reds with Christchurch second and BTC third. Christchurch won the Ladies Junior Fours with Poole in second and the Ladies Novice Fours saw a win for Lymington with Coalporters in third and in the veteran open fours Christchurch took the honours.



The aggregate Trophy, which is the open events is a Club award was presented to Bidiford Reds – although the Hants & Dorset was the best Association in the open events as well, - with, if you apply three points for a first, two for second and one for third - the Hants & Dorset had 26 points against 13 for CARA and 9 for the West of England. The South Coast Rules state that the Veteran Fours will not count towards the aggregate shield – had it done so Christchurch would have won the Dartmouth Trophy – as it stands Christchurch and Ryde were equal runners up – with one win and one second place against Bidiford Reds two wins.

When the history of the South Coast Championship Regatta is written the record will probably show a successfully completed Regatta - but in my view they were very lucky to get a way with what was a poorly organised, at times unsafe Regatta and where the South Coast Council Rules had been flouted in several areas by the host Association. In contrast the hospitality of the two Bidiford Clubs was as good as ever.
