The Association Secretaries Report on the 2005 Coastal Season.

Thirteen Regatta's made up the 2005 Hants & Dorset ARA Championship program - two less than in 2004 - which reflected a desire within the Association to reduce the number of Championship Regattas. Worthing withdrew their Regatta following discussions on the Regatta program at the Associations AGM and Southampton Town fell foul of the problem of finding a suitable date when all the services would be available, funding and a shortage of volunteers to run the event. Both these Regattas may be reinstated in the future - perhaps at the expense of others - and the debate on the appropriate number of Regattas to make up the Hants & Dorset Championship program will continue. Milford Regatta, run by Lymington R. C was the only Regatta to fall foul of the weather - it was correctly cancelled on the Friday before the event was due - and successfully staged on a new date later in the season. Shanklin Regatta had to cope with worsening conditions on the day leading to the cancellation of most of the small boat events. Entries at entry cut-off in Championship events fell from 1385 in 2004 to 1220 in 2005, partly explained by the loss of two Regattas from the calendar - and I also believe that support for the non-championship trial events increased. Late entries also seemed to be higher, so perhaps Clubs are taking a more careful approach with initial entries - but I do not have the data to back this view up. Four Regattas had more than 100 entries showing in their programmes - Itchen, Swanage, Southsea and Poole - with Southsea's 179 entries discounted because of the entries from two Associations - Swanage with 110 entries was arguably the largest H&D Regatta - which is a concern as with no local Club this is one of the most difficult to organise.

While entries may have fallen the standard of competition remained high and there was some excellent racing during the season with very few major incidents - either disciplinary or from a safety point of view recorded. The general level of cooperation from the athletes continues to improve and the trial races in different boat types and statuses added to the atmosphere, although, of course, the Championship events remained the focus of interest.

It initially appeared that for the first time for several years that a Men's Senior Four from BTC would not dominate this Championship. In the first five Regattas there were wins for Lymington, Ryde and three for Christchurch making them the front-runners. But at Woolston Regatta the familiar colours of BTC emerged as winners and from that point on there were only two Clubs in contention - BTC eventually emerging once again as Hants & Dorset Men's Senior Champions - by the closest of margins, just one point separating them from Christchurch at the end of the season. These two crews went on to represent the Association at the South Coast Championships where Christchurch finished 3rd and BTC stopped before the line while in second place.

The Men's Junior Senior Fours suffered from a shortage of crews - with no race at four Regattas and only two Clubs, and therefore no point at another three. Christchurch and Ryde won four races each - with Christchurch claiming the Championship for their three points to Ryde's two. These two Clubs represented the Association at the South Coast Championships - Ryde finishing in 3rd place and Christchurch 4th.

The Men's Junior Fours was much more one-sided Ryde winning eight of the twelve events staged to claim the Hants & Dorset Championship and going on to win the South Coast Championships race with an equally dominating performance. Southsea won twice to secure 2nd place in the Hants & Dorset Championship and representative honours finishing 4th in the South Coast Championship event. During the Hants & Dorset Season BTC and Coalporters recorded single wins but no points and Poole won the point for their second place at Southsea Regatta.

Itchen Imperials impressive young squad dominated the Men's Novice Fours Championship - reaping the benefit of their work with Cadets - with five wins and points from three Crews. Southsea, Christchurch, Southampton and Poole all had two wins and a crew promoted to Junior status in a season where the quality of the Novice Men's Crews was of an encouraging high standard.

Coalporters continued their domination of the Ladies Fours racing retaining both the Senior and Junior Ladies Fours Titles with dominating performances. In the Senior event they won all but one of the thirteen races held taking eight points with Southsea managing a solitary win - these two going on to represent the Association at the South Coast Championships with Coalporters adding this title to their achievements, Southsea finishing 4th. The Ladies Junior Fours suffered from a lack of support early in the season but Coalporters won nine of the thirteen events held taking five points that were available. Poole, who had been Coalporters only serious competition won the last Regatta of the season to secure South Coast representative honours alongside Coalporters - who won the Championship race with Poole a very creditable 2nd.

Ryde, with four wins and points, from two crews emerged as the Associations Novice Ladies Fours Champions, Itchen were runners-up with their three wins and Christchurch, Southsea and Lymington also all had crews promoted to Junior status following their two wins each.

The Veteran Fours was a close contest with three Clubs in contention - Southsea, Christchurch and Poole - and was not decided until the last Regatta of the season won by Christchurch to give them five points and the Association Championship by the narrowest of margins, just the one point separating them from Poole with Southsea's two points putting them 3rd. Christchurch and Poole duly represented the Association at the South Coast - Christchurch confirming their Champions status with a win with Poole finishing in 4th.

The Men's Senior Pairs was another very close Championship decided at the last Regatta of the season where Lymington held of the challenge from Itchen to claim a 6th win and point to retain the title - Itchen taking 5 wins and points.

Lack of entries in the early Regattas had an impact of the Men's Junior Pairs event with only ten events held and half of these with insufficient entries to have a point awarded. Coalporters with four points from their seven wins emerged as Champions from Poole with 2 wins and one point and Southsea with a single point. Although there was a race at Southsea Regatta, won by a CARA Club there was only one H&D Pair involved.

The Southsea Ladies Senior Pair dominated their event winning on 9 occasions and claiming 7 points to comfortably secure this Championship the only serious challenge coming from Christchurch and BTC.

Nick Pike from Ryde achieved back-to-back Men's Senior Single Sculling Championships with another dominating performance winning eight of the ten events held and on two occasions Ryde achieved 1st, 2nd and 3rd in this event. Matt Allsopp from Ryde - James Foad of Itchen and Brian Ingle from Coalporters all secured single wins.

The Men's Junior Sculls Championship went to W. Powell of Westover, who, more often than not was the only competitor from this Club entered in the Regatta. He won on five occasions his nearest rival being Salter from Ryde with two points. Bailey of BTC and Chinn of Coalporters won one point each.

Itchen Imperial won the Men's Novice Sculls Championship with four wins and points from two scullers. Christchurch, Coalporters and BTC had two wins each.

Cynthia Mynhardt of Southsea won both the Senior and Junior Ladies Sculls Championships. After six wins and five points in the Junior events, enough to secure the Championship she switched to Ladies Senior Sculls for the last two Regattas - where due to lack of entries no points had yet been awarded, and won both to secure a unique double Sculling Championship. Hume of BTC represented the main challenge at Senior Sculls - with the misfortune of winning four races but no points - Creswell of Christchurch also winning a point less race. In the Junior Sculls the main challenge came from McGregor-Ritchie of Southampton with three wins and Crockett of Christchurch with a single win.

The Novice Ladies sculling championship was a three-way tie between Coalporters, Christchurch and Lymington who each had two wins, Southampton, Southsea and Itchen recording single wins.

Maria Carery of Coalporters was awarded Coxswain of the Year following the closest of competitions with Catherine Hume from BTC.

Coalporters 35 wins in Hants & Dorset Championship events makes them the Associations most successful Club in the Coastal season with Southsea with 32 wins in second and Ryde with 28 in third.

Club registrations at 417 at the beginning of the season and 116 added during the year to total 529 was 35 down on the 2004 total of 570 - a downward trend that has to be of concern. Poole with 72 members registered show as the largest Club with Christchurch next on 71 - and Coalporters 3rd largest with 68. The Itchen Junior Sprint Regatta at the end of the season had over one hundred Juniors from seven Hants & Dorset Clubs competing, who in the main are probably not registered and is an encouraging sign but the further small drop in both Regatta entries and registrations remains an area of concern for the Association which we must try to address and radical solutions may be required.

The Association Secretaries Report on the 49th South Coast Rowing Championships, 3rd September, 2005, Bexhill, East Sussex.

The Coast Amateur Rowing Association hosted the 49th South Coast Rowing Championships, at Bexhill, East Sussex, on Saturday, 3rd September, 2005. To the organising committees great credit this was a very well organised and run event which benefited from substantial sponsorship which sets precedents for future Championships that they will find difficult to match without similar financial backing. In addition to some excellent racing the well supported Friday evening reception and Championship draw with an extensive buffet, free wine and special presentations plus the Saturday evening Prize Giving and party with Rowing Celebrity guest and Firework display were among the Social highlights along with the extensive hospitality shown to the VIP's from all three Associations. The organisation and facilities for the Regatta itself matched those of the social side with only minor criticisms - the finish line was difficult to see, the beach marshals hard to find on occasions and the programme of events could have been slightly better laid out - with more time between Championship races to give Clubs with more than one crew the opportunity to use their best boats more than once. The gloriously hot weather added to the enjoyment although the wind - a force 2 to 3 - maybe 4 on occasions - blowing easterly straight down the course made the conditions uncomfortable - and it would not have taken much more to cause real difficulties - exposing, once again, the problems of a Coastal venue - and the lack of a viable alternative course.

The major disappointment - especially for the organisers who had worked so hard to put on this event - was the almost complete lack of support from the West of England ARA. They had no representatives in the Veterans, and Ladies Junior Fours Championships and only one crew in the Men's Junior, Junior Senior and Ladies Senior Championships - and even then the Crew in the Men's Junior and Junior Senior Championship was the same one. In addition to the five Championship crews (of a possible twelve) there was just one crew entered in the open and invitation events a Men's Novice crew from Bideford Reds. Exeter, Grenville College, Dartmouth and Bideford Reds were the only West of England Clubs involved. WEARA probably had more Association Officials in attendance at this event than they did athletes. It would be nice to think that this lack of support was because of the travel involved or the need to switch into Coastal Boats - but the truth is that the support from the West of England Clubs for this Championship is only a little better when they host the event. This is a real concern for future organisers of this event and is without doubt the most serious threat to its continued existence.

The Regatta had a total of 110 entries - 29 in the Championship races, that is a full complement of 12 from the Hants & Dorset & CARA and five from WEARA. There were therefore 81 entries in the open and invitation events - 40 each from the Hants & Dorset and CARA and the one from WEARA.

The racing throughout the day was of the highest quality in the difficult conditions. The first Championship event was the Men's Junior Fours where the Hants & Dorset got off to a flying start with a dominating performance from the Hants & Dorset Champions from Ryde who quickly established a lead that they never lost and had grown to three lengths at the finish. The two CARA representatives from and Bexhill finished second and third with the 2nd Hants & Dorset Crew from Southsea in 4th.

The Hants & Dorset continued this form in the next Championship event - the Veterans - with once again the Hants & Dorset Champions from Christchurch winning in some style from CARA representatives Folkestone in second and Hastings in 3rd, the second H&D representatives from Poole finishing 4th.

Next came the big one - the Men's Senior Fours for the Bidiford Bowl - so often in the past this has been a close fought race and so it proved this time with Hants & Dorset Champions BTC and CARA Champions Herne Bay locked together for most of the race. With 500m to go BTC had a slight lead and it appeared they would hold on but Herne Bays final push, as with Shoreham last year, was just enough to snatch the lead. Then came the twist in the tail - also a feature of many bowl races. BTC and the two WEARA representatives had failed to cross the line promoting the second representatives from CARA - home Club Bexhill to second - and the 2nd Hants & Dorset representatives from Christchurch to third!

But a return to winning ways followed in the next Championship event - the Senior Ladies - with Hants & Dorset Champions Coalporters winning comfortably from CARA representatives Dover in 2nd and Deal in 3rd with the Hants Dorset 2nd crew from Southsea in 4th place.
