#### THE ASSOCIATION SECRETARIES REPORT ON THE 2006 SEASON.

With the welcome return of Southampton Town Regatta a full program of fourteen Championship Regatta's were staged - and with the issue of permits to three Head Races (Southampton Small & River, Southampton Coastal and the Head of the Stour) the Association administered and supported seventeen events during the 2006 season.

Excluding these Head Races and in spite of the return of Southampton Town Regatta entries have continued to fall - from 1216 in 2005 to 1196 (assumes the same entry for BTC Regatta where the figure is not available) - a drop of twenty - or 1.6% - a small drop but one that needs to be reversed. Average entry in 2006 was 85 against 93 in 2005. The figures relate to Championship events only. At close of entries only Southsea, with the advantage of being a combined Regatta with the Coast exceeded 100 entries - although several others - notably Coalporters, Swanage and Poole will have exceeded 100 entries once the non H&D Championship and late entries are taken into account.

In contrast to the entries registrations have increased significantly to 620 against 536 in 2005 and increase of 84 or 15.6%. 508 of these were at first registration with 112 added during the season. The mix between Men and Women is - The largest Club, by registration is Coalporters followed by Christchurch and BTC. Coalporters and Southampton show the most growth - almost certainly a reflection on their successful Junior Sections.

Turning to the Coastal Regatta season the Mens Senior Fours was the closest contest for several years with two Clubs - BTC and Ryde sharing the points between them with BTC eventually retaining the Championship with their eight wins and points from Ryde with six. These two Clubs duly represented the Association at the South Coast Championships at Dartmouth with Ryde getting the better of their old rivals on this occasion to finish 2nd with BTC a disappointing 5th.

The Mens Junior Senior Fours Championship was even tighter - and went to the wire - with three Clubs - Itchen, Ryde and Southsea in close contention and going into the last Regatta each Club had four points. Itchen won the final race to secure the Championship - Ryde and Southsea contesting a row-off to secure the 2nd South Coast representative place - which Ryde won - and then had the better of Itchen at Dartmouth finishing 2nd with Itchen in 3rd.

In contrast the Mens Junior Fours proved to be a relatively easy Championship win for Itchen with 11 wins and 9 points and only BTC - with 2 wins and Southsea with 1 mounting any real challenge. Itchen went on to prove their Champion status with a fine win at Dartmouth with Hants & Dorset second representatives BTC finishing in 6th place.

Six different Clubs won at Mens Novice Fours - the Championship going to Christchurch with their four wins and points. Southsea, Southampton, Lymington and Itchen each secured two wins and Ryde a single win - although the winning composite crew at BTC Regatta - included all but one of the Ryde oarsman.

The Ladies Senior Fours title was retained by Coalporters - with nine wins and seven points, in a close contest with Southsea, who won on five occasions - these two Clubs going on to represent the Association at Dartmouth where Coalporters finished 3rd and Southsea 4th.

The Ladies Junior Fours was another close contest not decided until the last Regatta when Christchurch claimed their 6th win to secure the Championship over Southsea who had five wins - with Ryde also mounting a challenge which gave them three wins and two points. Christchurch and Southsea duly represented the Association at Dartmouth Southsea finishing 3rd and Christchurch in 5th place.

Six different Clubs won Ladies Novice Fours events - the Championship going to Coalporters with their three wins - with Southsea and Westover's two wins each making them runners-up. Single wins were recorded by Itchen, BTC and Christchurch.

Three Clubs battled for the Veteran Fours Championship - Lymington and Poole making the early running threatened by a late challenge from BTC. But it was Lymington with five wins that emerged as Champions, with Poole 2nd with 3 wins and BTC 3rd with two wins. Lymington and Poole represented the Association at Dartmouth - with taking Poole 2nd place and Lymington finishing 4th.

Itchen Imperial, who had threatened Lymington's recent dominance of the Mens Senior Pairs Championship last year - duly reversed the position, taking the Championship with seven wins from Lymington with three and Southampton and Poole snatching one win each.

Itchen went on to complete a Mens Pairs "double" as they won the Mens Junior Pairs Championship as well in an event that continues to receive little support - Itchen claiming the Championship by taking the only three points awarded.

Support for the Ladies Senior Pairs event was even worse with just a single qualifying race giving Southampton this Championship with the one point awarded.

There was arguably more interest in the trial double sculls event than the Mens Junior and Ladies Senior Pairs - especially when you consider that this is still restricted by the number of boats available.

However the Mens Single Sculling events continue to attract good entries - especially the Seniors in spite of the continued domination of the event by Ryde's Nick Pike who secured his third consecutive Championship winning all but one of the races to claim a total of twelve points. Allsopp, also from Ryde was more often than not his closest rival finishing second on eight occasions - but it was Williams of Coalporters who secured the only other win - at a time when fortunately for him he had already secured the Mens Junior Sculling Championship with 9 wins - as he immediately lost his Junior status when he won the Senior event. Benham of Itchen, Frith of Southampton and Edawrds of BTC also won Junior Sculling races to secure Senior status for next season.

The Mens Novice Sculls brought further success to Itchen where their four winning scullers, who gained seven wins and points between then secured their Club this Championship - with Ryde and Southampton with two wins each in second place.

Support for the Ladies Sculling events remains disappointing the Senior title going to Lisa McGregor-Ritchie of Southampton with the only point awarded and the Ladies Junior Sculls title going to Jess Heyes of Coalporters with the only point awarded in that event. The Ladies Novice Sculls was a little better supported - which gives some hope to the future of Ladies Sculling - Coalporters three wins and points giving them this Championship from Christchurch and Itchen with two points each.

So after a long but relatively trouble free season Itchen Imperial emerged as the Associations most successful Club with 37 Championship Points won to become the first recipients of the R. S. O. "Hank" Carr memorial trophy - with Ryde's 27 Points giving them the runners-up slot and Coalporters with 24 in third place.

Elliott Weaver of Itchen Imperial Rowing Club received the prestigious Coxswaon of the year award following another very close contest and the Evening Echo Trophy in memory of Arthur Chatfield awarded for services to the Hants & Dorset ARA and Coastal rowing went to Keith Warland for his many years of service as President, Chairman and Treasurer of the Association and as a Racing Official and South Coast Council delegate.

It is appropriate in this report to give a brief report on the British and International Coastal Rowing Challenge and the World Coastal Rowing Challenge held in Gurnsey at the beginning of September. A number of Crews from the Hants & Dorset - and CARA - competed and performed impressively with our design of Coastal boat proving to be very stable, safe - and fast - in very rough conditions. Coalporters Senior Ladies crew won the British Open Fours event and the Ladies Open fours in the World Coastal Rowing Challenge.

## 2. The Association Secretary's Report on the 50th South Coast Championship Regatta, at Dartmouth on the 16th September, 2006.

The 50th South Coast Championships, an event inspired by the Hants & Dorset ARA's Archie Fraser, was held at Dartmouth, on 16th September and hosted by the West of England Amateur Rowing Association and included the first South Coast Junior Regatta and celebrations to mark the 50th anniversary of the event.

Among the celebrations was a Dinner held on the Thursday evening before the Regatta at which presentations were made to South Coast Council Life Member including the Hants & Dorset's Ted Shergold and Brent Hartland - and posthumously to Pat Sherwin, MBE, which was handed over to Southsea R. C. The dinner also saw the publication of a history of the first 50 years of the Championships - an excellent book compiled by the Coasts Phil Challen and our own Denny Woodford that included full records of all the Regattas plus photos and anecdotes. A traditional brooch/lapel pin was also distributed and during the Regatta a row-past of "Vintage" Crews who had competed at the first Regatta in 1957 was staged which included a crew representing the Hants & Dorset ARA (Mike Green, Brent Hartland, Frank Quinten and David Smirk) and a crew from BTC (Mike Collins, Keith Weaver MBE, Denis Woodford and Peter Wardell). All these fitting celebrations were well received and enjoyed by the participants and spectators and helped to celebrate a significant milestone in this, the South Coast's major rowing Regatta.

The inaugural Junior Regatta - inspired by the Hants & Dorset ARA and its 2007 Regatta organising committee who had first promoted the idea, was staged in the morning with events for Men's and Ladies J18 Coxed Fours, Men's and Ladies J16 and J14 Coxed Quads and Men's and Ladies J14 and J16 Double Sculls. thirty-four Crews were entered - with the majority - 19 - not surprisingly coming from the West of England with 11 from the Hants & Dorset and 4 from CARA. The racing, over a 1000m course, was often close and exciting and added considerably to the spectacle of the event and will hopefully be staged when ever practical and will hope go from strength to strength and become a vital element of the Regatta.

The main Regatta which was held in the afternoon had an entry of 102 crews - the lowest for at least six years and included a full quota of Championship Crews from each Association - except for the West of England who, disappointingly for a WEARA hosted Championships could only muster one crew for the Men's Senior Fours Championship. Sixty-seven crews were entered in the Open and Invitation events - 34 of these coming from Hants & Dorset Clubs, 26 from CARA and just a pathetic 7 from the West of England - another very disappointing figure for a host Association and one that must remain a major concern for the future of the fixture.

[Note: Only Dartmouth with 3 Crews, Bidiford ARC with 2, Bidiford AAC with 1 and Exeter with 1 were entered in the Invitation and Open events - where were - Paignton, Plymouth, Dart Totnes, Falmouth, Torquay and the WEARA Clubs - three of whom have enjoyed the full support of the Hants & Dorset ARA and CARA Crews for South Coast Championship Regatta's in their Towns in recent years!]

Turning to the racing - and the Championship events, these were a disappointment from the Hants & Dorset ARA with just one Championship win - the Associations worst performance for many years.

It was Itchen Imperial who kept the flag flying for the Hants & Dorset with in the Men's Junior Fours. Always in contention they eased into the lead at around the 500m mark and never looked like losing this position although Dart Totnes pushed them hard over the final stages of the race. The Associations 2nd representative, BTC, finished 6th.

In the Men's Senior Fours Championship it was the Association runners-up, Ryde who mounted the strongest challenge. In 4th place at the half way stage they rowed through the field to finish in second place less than a length behind Bexhill. Like their Men's Junior Crew, BTC, the Association Champions, never got going finishing in 5th.

The Association Championship runners-up, from Ryde, also mounted the stronger challenge in the Championship Junior Senior Fours finishing 2nd behind Bexhill with Association Champions Itchen in third.

In the Ladies Senior Fours Association Champions Coalporters led in the early stages but were over powered by Exeter and Greenbank Falmouth and eventually finished 3rd with the Associations other representatives, Southsea, finishing 5th.

The Junior Ladies Championship was won by Exeter who were convincing winners, by three lengths over Shoreham with Hants & Dorset runners-up Southsea a further 3 lengths back in third place and Champions Christchurch in 5th.

For a while we thought that a second Championship win for the Association would come in the Veteran Fours, where Association runners-up Poole moved into the lead at the 500m mark but the West of England representatives Dart Tomes and CARA's Folkestone slowly closed them down. At 1500m their was less than three feet between the three crews but in the final 300m Poole had nothing left to offer and dropped back to third, the Hants & Dorset Champions Lymington finishing 4th. Both crews were promoted by one place when the winning Dart Totnes crew was subsequently disqualified.

Folkestone's promotion to first place in this event helped them to secure the Bass Charrington Shield for the most successful Association in the Championship events.

The Hants & Dorset ARA fared better in the supporting Open and Invitation events with Ryde winning the Men's Open Senior Fours from Christchurch and finishing 1st and 2nd in the Ladies Junior Fours, with Southamton 3rd - enough to secure the Island Club and our Association the Port of Dartmouth

Sesquicentennial Trophy for the most successful Club in the supporting events. The Association also had wins in the Men's Junior Fours, from Southsea, with Christchurch second, the Men's Novice Fours - from Poole, with Itchen second and the Senior Ladies Fours - from Southampton where Coalporters finished 3rd. There were also second places for Southsea in the Junior Senior Fours - won by Shoreham and in the Ladies Novice Fours, won by Worthing, from BTC who also finished second in the Veterans event behind Bexhill. Controversy marred the end of the Regatta when it emerged that two members of the winning Dart Totnes crew in the Veterans Championship event had not met the qualification criteria by competing in three West of England Regatta's during the season. A hastily convened Council meeting, with Steve Bull, deputising for the absent Bob Sivier as one of the three H&D Delegates, considered the situation, splitting along "party lines" to defeat by six votes to three a proposal from the West of England delegates that the result should stand - and as a result Dart Totnes were disqualified. The crew had hardly helped the situation by "bragging" that they had not met the criteria during the Regatta.

The Regatta was well organised and efficiently run, starting on time and finishing just ten minutes late - which is a credit to the organisers, officials and competing crews. Information received prior to the Regatta was a big improvement on past West of England hosted events although the published program was very basic and disappointing. The commentary and control during the Regatta - including a delayed but useful Captains briefing - were well done helping the event to run smoothly. Unfortunately. Having been delayed by the need to attend the emergency South Coast Council Meeting I did not get to the prize giving and am unable to pass comment other than I felt that the event lacked a central location - near the Regatta site - a marquee in Coronation Park - or similar - to keep people together post Regatta. Also there was a strange lack of publicity in the Town and many locals seemed unaware of the event and the opportunities it gave them.

However, all things considered, and while disappointing from a Hants & Dorset perspective I think, that by West of England standards, this was a very well organised and efficiently run Regatta, worthy of a 50th anniversary and the West of England ARA and the Dartmouth organising committee are to be congratulated on staging a very successful event.

Finally can I acknowledge and thank John Bailey for his assistance in providing some of the information for this report and for allowing me to "crib" some parts of his press report.

We now look forward to the next fifty years where the event will continue to face many challenges and opportunities - the first coming next year when the Hants & Dorset hosts the event at Dorney Lake, the 2012 Olympic venue. We can only hope that the choice of venue will inspire greater support from the West of England Crews - and that the fallout from the Dart Totnes disqualification will be minimal.
